Read Matthew 6:25-34. What are some things that jump out to you? How would you paraphrase what Jesus is saying?

In the second part of verse 25 Jesus gives some examples of what you should not worry about. Is there anything we can worry about?

In verses 26 and 28-29 Jesus gives us some examples of how to remind ourselves not to worry. Why do you think he uses those examples? What are some examples you can think of?

Jesus asks an important question in verse 27. Why does He ask it? Is there anything that worrying accomplishes?
